


Responsible Minerals Policy

We, the undersigned, declare the following:

At Sähkö-Rantek, we aim to be hazard- and conflict-free in all sourcing activities. This is ensured by guiding all sourcing activities to follow a diligent manner in all aspects of buying materials from local and global suppliers. All at-risk materials are sourced with this in mind and thus material certificates and declarations are mandatory from all suppliers, when dealing with any directly applicable components and materials, such as tin, tantalum, tungsten and gold (3TG), as well as all electronic components used for serially produced products that can potentially contain problematic substances.

Additionally, we aim to comply with applicable REACH and RoHS regulations and are considerate of SVHC and vPBT materials, requiring suppliers to provide Rantek with the relevant declarations and certificates at the time of sourcing, whenever deemed necessary.
